### What is **GRNOG**

# "A group of people working towards the evolution and growth of Greek Internet"

GRNOG (Greek Network Operators Group) is a community of professionals that are involved in the design, implementation, provisioning and operation of Greek Internet services, networks and infrastructure.

Within this scope, the purpose of the group is:

- to create a human network of professionals with common technical interests
- to facilitate the exchange of knowledge and information among its members
- to promote the cooperation between companies, bodies and parties related to the Greek Internet
- to disseminate Greek and global Internet developments, emerging technologies, best operating practices and standards
- to develop tools, policies, practices and means of communication that facilitate dayto-day operations and long-term design and planning

GRNOG was established in 2015. Since then, GRNOG conferences have been established as the place where networking and internet professionals meet and discuss.

## **Summary of GRNOG13**

GRNOG13 took place on September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at the National Library of Greece, at Stavros Niarchos Foundation Cultural Center.

GRNOG13 was our first full hybrid event; attendance was possible both physically and virtually, through zoom. Also, the event was live streamed for non-registered guests.



The full day event (09.00-18.00) hosted a variety of presentations from local and remote presenters on diverse topics within the interests of the group. The full agenda can be found at Appendix 1. Presentations and video recordings are available through the GRNOG13 web page.

119 people from a wide variety of companies and sectors registered to the event, with a turnout around 65% (78 checked in). Another 70 members participated remotely. A significant number of people also attended via live streaming.
